

## Road Committee Report

1/13/2020 thru 2/08/2020

### Road Work Completed

Set 18"x 20' property owner purchased culvert for driveway at 103 Remington Ridge

- Hauled sand mix to build up road crown transition at culvert
- Placed large boulders at inlet and outlet to minimize erosion

Worked middle Remington Ridge

- Removed large rocks from road way
- Dozer work to adjust road pitch. Built up diverters
- Crushed windrows as needed

Worked Upper Remington Ridge to Turn-Around

- Hauled and Placed 4 loads of rock and clay mix to repair road pitch at 112
- Hauled and Placed 1 load of road mix to cover rocky section at 114
- Dozer work and watered to set materials
- Trimmed tree limbs and hauled 1 load of brush to burn pile

Worked lower Tomahawk Trail

- Hauled and Placed 1 load of clay to cover rocky sections
- Reclaimed sandy materials to repair intersection at Yellow Knife

Worked Six Shooter from 106 to Remington Ridge

- Dozer work to cut rocky sections. Improved water drainage
- Maintainer to finish blade work

### Equipment Repairs & Maintenance

140G Maintainer

- Tire repair: Faulty valve stem core and o-ring replaced

Rock Crusher

- Replace drive belts. Pressure washed to remove rocks and dirt

John Deere 410G Backhoe

- Second oil change with filter at 1582 hours
- Replaced transfer fuel pump and fuel line seals
- Continue to clean cab interior and monitor engine fluids
- Purchased needed foot switch pedal to operate hydraulic breaker circuit
- Purchased Hydraulic Breaker and quick connect fittings for hose hookups
- Hookup hoses need ends replaced to fit quick connect fittings

### Road Material Processing

- Excavated and Screened 6 loads of sand and gravel
- Reclaimed roadside materials when available

### Additional Information

- Pushed up brush pile
- Caliche order is being processed by Jarratt's Dirt Work. Delivery as soon as possible.
- Scheduled to work main road next week after forecasted rain. The roller will be used to improve soil compaction. Clay will be hauled as needed to bind the loose gravels
- Working to finish Apache Mountain Trail
- Plan to work Section 5 as soon as possible
