Road Work and Repairs

Delivered two 36" x 24' culverts to 409 Bandolero Pass for property owner's driveway entrance Installed a donated 18" x 20' culvert with 8' concrete extension at 101 High Lonesome for roadbed Creek crossing repair at 402 Squaw Valley with reclaimed materials and tree removal on inlet side Worked Cochise Canyon from Community Center to Deer Run with dozer and motor grader Repairs at 201Colleen Canyon, 1 load mix to cover rocky section, Assist incoming pre-fab home Cut and hauled 3 trailer loads of limbs for the incoming home from Stagecoach to 209 Colleen Hauled and placed 9 loads of rock fill to repair deep road side trenches along 205 Cochise Canyon Hauled 1 load of road mix to cover rocky sections at 107 Cochise Canyon Worked Low Meadow from Cochise to 208 Low Meadow, 5 loads mix, 1 load rock fill Worked road washout on lower Tomahawk and Crazy Horse, Placed boulders and rock fill to repair Worked concrete crossing at 602 Tomahawk, added fill rock to ends, more is needed with the dozer Repair work at 106 Limpia Canyon to fill in ruts and rocky sections Worked upper Colleen Canyon to repair road washouts and ruts, more work still needed Assist DMRVFD in diverting water flow away from the west side of the station Installed one 12" x 20' culvert for property owner at 103 Thompson Trail
